# Notice

If you are asking (nominating) someone to collect your prescription on your behalf we will need a signed consent letter from you before we can release it. The consent letter needs to contain the **name of the nominated person, or persons** (if more than one person collects for you).

- If it is just a one off occasion, and you know in advance that you will be asking someone to collect it for you, the consent letter could be dropped in with your repeat prescription request.
- The signed consent letter can be brought in at the time of collection by the person collecting your prescription.
- If you will be regularly asking someone to collect your prescription, please inform us of this in your consent letter, the information can then be added to your notes for future reference.
- We can also accept verbal consent if you come into the Surgery in person.

**Please be aware that prescriptions will not be released without a signed consent letter or verbal consent**
